# PKFZ to facilitate foreign participation

PORT Klang Free Zone (PKFZ) is exploring the possibility of setting up a facilitation centre to introduce foreign investors to local business partners in Malaysia.

The proposal came from the Malay Chamber of Commerce Malaysia's (DPMM) Selangor branch that paid a working visit to the site recently.

PKFZ general manager Chia Kon Leong said in a statement that PKFZ would work together with DPMM to explore the idea of creating opportunities and introducing foreign companies to local businessmen.

"The foreign companies can source for products and services from the locals," he said.

Chairman of DPMS Corp Bhd (the business arm of the DPMM) Sohaimi Shahadan said the visiting group was

impressed with the wide range of facilities at the free zone.

"The usual red tape in setting up a business has been reduced or eliminated for foreigners, and locals can literally move in overnight into the existing facilities like the light-industrial units or the office blocks.

"Many of our members can see business growth opportunities with PKFZ," he said.

PKFZ is located in Pulau Indah and it is adjacent to Westports of Port Klang and close to Northport on the mainland.

It provides a total of 1,000 acres, of which the 600 acres comprise open land lots, 512 light industrial units, 500,000 sq ft office space, a business-class hotel and an exhibition centre.
