Port Klang Free Zone Appoints New MD

KUALA LUMPUR, April 3 (Bernama) -- Port Klang Free Zone (PKFZ), Malaysia's first fully integrated free commercial and industrial zone, has appointed Noel Gulliver as its new managing director to lead the team.
