Dubai-based operator pulls out of PKFZ

PETALING JAYA: Jebel Ali Free Zone (Jafza), a Dubai-based and world leading free zone operator, has withdrawn from the management concession for Port Klang Free Zone (PKFZ).

Jafza said in a statement yesterday that it had given formal notice of termination to PKFZ yesterday.

The RM4bil PKFZ project, located

on 405ha on Pulau Indah, Port Klang was targeted to be the industrial and commercial free zone powerhouse for South-East Asia, modelled after Jebel Ali Free Zone Area.

It is fully owned by Port Klang Authority (PKA) and was managed and marketed by Jafza International on a 15-year contract since October 2004 up to yesterday.
