FREQUENT ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS FREE ZONE (DEFINITION - UNDER FREE ZONE ACT 1990)

- A Free Zone has the meaning assigned to it under section 2 of the Customs Act 1967, Excise Act 1976, Sales Tax Act 1972, Service Tax 1975 and for the purpose of the Acts shall be place deemed to be a place outside Malaysia.
- A Free Zone is deemed a place outside federation (outside country) except in respect of prohibition of import and export under section 31 of the Customs Act 1967.
- A Free Zone area is mainly designed to promote entreport trade and manufacturing industries producing goods essentially for export.
- Port Klang Free Zone Authority comprise of Free Commercial and Free Industrial Zone.
- Free Commercial Zone – for commercial activity which includes trading, break bulk, grading, repacking, relabeling and transit.
- Free Industrial Zone – for manufacturing activity.

HOW TO REGISTER AS OPERATOR AND OBTAIN THE WAREHOUSE CODE/USER ID IN PKFZ

- Client must complete the FORM ZB4 (Application to carry out an activity in Free Zone)
- The form is in PKFZ Free Zone Department
- The Free Zone Authority will check the form. If the form is completed as per checklist, Free Zone Authority will issue the ZB 6 Approval with warehouse/manufacturing code for the applicant/customers.
- The validity of this approval is 1 or 2 years subject to business activity.

HOW TO REGISTER AS OPERATOR IN PKFZ INTREGATED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (PIMS)

- Upon ZB6 approval by the Free Zone Authority, customer may use the approved warehouse code as ID to do PKFZ GCS REGISTRATION at following URL – <https://pkfz-gcs.dagangnet.com.my>
- The guideline for PIMS registration as per attached.

HOW TO REGISTER AS FORWARDING AGENT/TRANSPORTER IN PKFZ INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (PIMS)

- Approved Freight forwarder/forwarding agent/transporter by The Royal Malaysian Custom (such as BF code) and/or Port Klang Authority under the approved Port Klang User (BZ code)

may register to PKFZ Integrated Management System (PIMS) at following URL – <https://pkfz-gcs.dagangnet.com.my>

HOW TO REGISTER AS PORT KLANG USER IN PORT KLANG AUTHORITY

- Freight forwarder/forwarding agent/transporter prior to the registration of PIMS is require to obtain approval by The Port Klang Authority under the <http://my1port.com/>
- New Port Klang user (Freight forwarder/Logistics company/forwarding agent) upon registration at <http://my1port.com/Forms/LPKRegistration/CompanyRegistrationBM.aspx> shall obtain (BZ code) for further registration in PKFZ Integrated Management System (PIMS)
